

## **CENTRAL BAND FEES**

**Make CHECKS to CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL BAND**

**First Semester Fee = \$250 (May 25 \$75, June 25th \$75, July 25, \$100 )**

**New member fee: \$35**

### **FALL BAND FEES COVER THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM COSTS:**

- Marching uniform rental /gloves (first pair)
- Marching camp staff/clinicians
- Marching equipment/supplies
- Marching drill writing (field show)
- Music & arrangements, Pep Band Music
- Contest fees,
- Buses to contests and football games
- Guard: Instructional staff, Equipment
- New Concert Music Costs

**New Member Fee:** \$35; includes shoes and gloves, Lunsford's Music Sizes students for shoes and gloves and will invoice the order! **These expenses are separate from Band fees and should be paid separately from the band fee.**

### **Second Semester Fee: \$25 (fee is waived if student is in fall band)**

- Concert camp staff/clinicians, Contest fees, Transportation, Music & arrangements

### **FEES DO NOT COVER:**

- Replacement of out-grown, lost, or damaged items
- Guard: Shoes, Warm-ups, Uniform
- Other accessories such as sticks, reeds, books, mouthpieces, drum heads
- Sectional Shirts
- Central Shirts
- New Instruments
- First Set of Show Shirts

### **Fall Band Fees are separate from Booster Fees.**

- Booster Fees are a fundraising requirement during the school year and may be paid at any time. If a student meets their Booster Points requirement (Parent Volunteering, Donations, etc...) then his/her Booster Fee is met. We have two major fundraisers during the school year: the Fruit Sale in October, and the Chili Supper in March. We have many volunteering opportunities as well.
- Volunteer services beyond fundraising are an equally necessary component of the band program. All families are needed to help with food for students and receptions, chaperones, work crews, etc., throughout the school year.

### **Other Information:**

- All students will receive a Household Information Survey for further funding assistance. Students on fee waiver will be covered.
- **Students who join late will still pay full \$250.** New students to Central can have the semester fees prorated.
- There is a \$50 sibling discount for those families with more than one child in the CHS Band.

It is the intent of the Central High School Band Program to give all students the opportunity to participate in the program. If a student qualifies for the free/reduced program, all or part of the cash fees may be waived.

New member fees are due as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Semester prior to the start of band camp, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester prior to 2/1. New students will not be given shoes, t-shirts, concert uniforms, etc. until the new member fees have been paid.

**Refund Policy:** After Band Camp, student fees will not be refunded. A student dropping band because they do not like it or they decide it is too much work is not an excuse for a refund of fees. We budget our band camp staff based on the number of students paying fees.

I understand that I am responsible for the above fees. I further agree to pay these fees on or before the due dates stated. Failure to pay fees on a timely basis may result in my student(s) not being allowed to participate in band activities outside of the classroom. In addition, I understand that am responsible for any additional miscellaneous expenses incurred by my student.
